ADMISSION FOR M.Sc. CHEMISTRY PART - I
FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2021 – 2022

Date: 08/09/2021

M.Sc. Chemistry is a two year post-graduate course affiliated to Savitribai Phule Pune University (SPPU). The admission procedure for the first year of the course will start from 31/08/2021.

1. Note that the entire admission procedure is online this year.
2. All students who have passed B.Sc. (Chemistry) or equivalent examination are eligible for admissions to M.Sc. Chemistry.
3. All interested students should fill up merit form which will open from **31/8/2021 to 14/9/2021** (upto 5:00 pm.). The merit form should be filled through the website, the link for which is given below. Students should fill this form completely, correctly and upload the scanned copies of the necessary documents before submitting the same.

5. While filling the Merit Form, students should select "**PG NO GRANT**" section and under this section he should select the course "M.Sc. (Chemistry)". Note that the marks of the principal subject should be entered in the merit form.

For Savitribai Phule Pune University (SPPU) SYBSc & TYBSc (Principal).

For other university all marks of FY, SY & TY should be entered in the form.

The students should upload the following documents while filling merit form :

- a. Marksheet of B.Sc. Chemistry
- b. Caste Certificate, if applicable
- c. documents related to Ward of Serviceman / Ex-Serviceman, if applicable.
Sports / Cultural programs certificate (current academic year), if applicable

*** After filling merit form student should fill preference form compulsorily.**

Note that submitting the merit form does not guarantee admission.

6. All admissions are done strictly according to merit and reservation rules as per rules and regulations of Savitribai Phule Pune University and Government of Maharashtra.
7. **Schedule of admission:**
 - (a) **The date for the first merit list will be notified in due course of time. The students who haven't completed their merit form and preference should update it immediately.**
 - (b) Candidate from the above merit list should fill the online admission form. The Departmental Admission Committee will verify your admission form and approve online. After approving the admission form students will get notification on their registered mobile number and Email-Id. Such students are expected to pay the fees online from their login and complete admission formalities within a given time.

- (c) If the students fail to complete the admission process in given time, then they will forfeit their claim to admission. The successive rounds of admissions will be conducted, if necessary and the notifications for the same will be notified on the website.
- (d) A form filled up in the wrong category or not filled up completely or correctly or not having the appropriate documents specified above is likely to be rejected.
8. The students shall submit the printed copy of the admission form along with Original LC/TC, Photocopies of Graduation Marksheet, Caste Certificate (if applicable), Income Certificate (if applicable), Aadhar Card, Online payment receipt & other necessary documents after the regular college begins.
